What is the Pink Tower?

Walk into any Primary classroom, and your eyes will be drawn to the Pink Tower. At over 5' in height, this pink material draws attention. Why is the Pink Tower When Maria pink? Montessori experimented with different colors, pink was chosen most frequently by the children she was working with. As a material, the sensorial Pink Tower helps young children with hand-eye coordination, motor skills, and visual discrimination of dimensionalitydifferences in each cube's height, width, length and weight. It is a well-loved, well-used material in the **Primary** classroom.






