A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL/DIRECTOR. MR. ERIC

Welcome back, everyone. I hope you all had a restful and joyous holiday season. It looks like winter has finally arrived and this is a good time to remind everyone about our snow delay and cancellation policies. We rely on Washoe County School District to make the call for delays or closures. We will always reach out by phone message, text, and social media blasts, but you can get the word as quickly as we do by watching the news or checking the WCSD website (www.washoeschools.net) or the WCSD Facebook page.

When school is canceled, this includes all meetings, parent conferences, or any events that are planned that day. There will be no staff at school to take care of children and there will be no meals served. If it's too dangerous for children to come to school, it is also too dangerous for our staff to come to school.

When a 2-hour delayed start is called, morning meetings and conferences are canceled, and breakfast will not be served. There will be no staff on campus to take care of students until 10:20 for Elementary and Middle School, 10:35 for siblings, and 10:40 for primary students. Remember, if 2 hours are needed to make the roads safe for families, we need to make sure the roads are safe for staff as well.

Finally, if roads become unsafe during the school day after school has started, it is possible that we may cancel after-school meetings and aftercare. If this is the case, we will make that decision no later than 1:00 pm and texts, voice calls, and social media blasts will be sent as soon as possible.

Thank you for your understanding and for helping support the safety of our whole HDMS community.

Positive Discipline and the Plan for Better Choices

Positive discipline methods are used at HDMS to guide children's behavior and support their personal growth. Through positive reinforcement, communication and validation of emotions, children can make constructive choices and problem solve.

The Plan for Better Choices is part of HDMS' positive discipline approach. The Plan is used to address an undesired behavior and to discuss alternative choices that could be made. The Plan also incorporates a restorative approach by allowing the child to be part of the consequence or restoration process.

If a Plan for Better Choices comes home with a child, it is intended to inform the parents/ guardian about an undesired behavior that occurred, and the resolution that was chosen. In most cases, the resolution/ consequence has already been completed.




